1) CHILD PROTECTION PROJECT

- Child abuse poster was developed and printed and made available for distribution
- Inter-agency child protection standard procedure leaflet was developed.
- Community evaluation data was analyzed and preliminary report done.

2) OTHER MATTERS

- Poster addressing the impact of domestic violence on children completed, copy attached for comments.
- Sessions at the health centres were put on hold from 19th December until January 2012 due to poor clinic attendance. However brochures were given to clinics for distribution to persons who would have visited during the holidays. At the health centres, only persons who were uplifting medications and few pregnant mothers were coming in at intervals. This was due partly to the elections and the Christmas season.
- Statistics completed and sent off.
- Schools were contacted; work to begin in second week of January 2012
