- 27 parenting programmes completed being (project target of no. of persons reached, exceeded)
- 6 youth empowerment programmes were completed in the target communities
- 1 community-based multi-stakeholders workshop completed
- Community-based action groups in all 3 target communities established
- 3 community-based action plans drafted
- Counseling targets for project surpassed by approximately over 100%
- First draft of cross-cutting inter-sector protocols and procedures and collaboration gaps identified by various sectors who work for the protection and wellbeing of children
- Equipment acquisition for prudent roll out of project action achieved. (See attached Annexes 1-6)

6. Constraints

- Non-attendance of law enforcement at the inter-sector forum
- National elections activities restrained some scheduled activities within all the communities
- Preparation for the national elections affected the final 2 months of project action, especially the scheduled inter-sector forums on protocols standardization in response to child sexual abuse, and training workshops
- DVD and poster and brochures publication delayed
- Community-based groups still require tangible support for sustaining some semblance of project action which was rolled out during the project implementation period.

7. Follow-up and priorities for this activity in the next quarter – if applicable:

- Expand the reach of parenting and youth forums that will engage un-met persons and groups within the target communities and commence work in a community located in the interior
- Increase work with faith-based groups within the communities
- Re-engage the multi-stakeholder sectors to update of draft protocol reflective of inter-agency collaboration
- Establish child friendly spaces within the communities that will engage the advocacy the skills acquired by the persons who comprise the community based action teams
- Enhance a referral system at schools and community which will be monitored by the community champions of child rights
- Conduct an inter-community retreat for review of lessons learned and update of community action plans
- Public promotion of child protection protocols and updating of community action plans
- Arts and drama activities for the promotion of youth empowerment
